Minutes of Council meeting held on 9th July 2015 in Langore Village Hall at 1950

15/44 **Present:** Cllrs. V Lindley, S Lindley, Geoff Cowling, Gill Cowling, J Caudle, M Rimmer and J Heaton Clerk in attendance

15/46 **Declarations of interest:** Cllr Caudle, aspects of the pond,

15/47 **Minutes:** Minutes of the meeting held on 11th June 2015 and reconvened meeting 12 June 2015 were agreed.

15/48 **Grass Cutting and Flower Beds;** The footpath from The Green to the Kissing Gate is to be cut back and the Green will be cut in preparation for the Parish Day.

The verge cutting in Truscott was Cormac in preparation for resurfacing. Cllr Caudle met with their representatives and any resurfacing of the highway will keep impact on the pond and its environs to a minimum.
